Shayla Rivera '83

Texas A&M University Engineering Professor of Practice

Before she was a Professor of Practice, Shayla Rivera '83 was an Aerospace Engineer with NASA working on the Space Shuttle and Space Station Programs and soon moved into engineering technical sales.
